REFERENCE GUIDE Item Codes & Descriptions

This guide has been created to assist providers with item code determination when completing Forms 83D13 (*Invoice for Prosthetic Services*) and 83D19 (*Request for Authorization for Prosthetic Services*)

Lower Extremity	
19225	Hemipelvectomy Socket - Socket Fee
19224	Hip Disarticulation Socket– Socket Fee
19223	Trans-Femoral Socket – Socket Fee
19222	Knee Disarticulation Socket – Socket Fee
19221	Trans-Tibial Socket – Socket Fee
19220	Symes Socket – Socket Fee
19231	Partial Foot Prosthesis – Socket Fee
19281	Early Post-Operative Procedure – Lower Extremity
19282	Diagnostic Socket – Lower Extremity
19283	Suction Procedure – Lower Extremity
19284	Lock Procedure – Lower Extremity
19232	Socket Variations – Lower Extremity
19240	Suspensions and Additions – Lower Extremity Includes all belts, harnesses
19241	Suspension Sleeves – Lower Extremity All sleeves; gaiters; knee covers; protectors
19285	Socket Liners – Lower Extremity
19234	Locking Devices – Lower Extremity Any of the locks. E.g. shuttle locks; strap locks that connect a liner to a prosthesis
19239	Hip Joint 7E7 or similar; includes pelvic joints for belts
19235	Knee Joint Includes the whole knee joint 3R60, a Mauch cylinder in a Black Max, C-leg, etc.
19236	Shank, Rotator – Torque Adaptor Any of the units that allow graded resistance to rotation or allow a segment to be freely rotated. E.g. Ossur Total Shock or Otto Bock Delta Twist
19237	Ankle Block, Ankle Joint Any joint or block with all necessary parts

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19238	Foot Any complete foot including Spectra Sock, foot shell, etc.
19260	Cosmetic Finishing – Lower Extremity Endoskeletal (foam) covers, exoskeletal (hard shell) covers, silicon or latex covering over finish (e.g. Dawskin, Synergy) – all part of cosmesis
19233	Components – Lower Extremity Any parts or pieces used in the prosthesis if no other specific Item Code is indicated. For example, a Shuttle Lock comes with 1 pin but if an extra pin is requested, it would still be included under 19234 – Locking Devices – Lower Extremity , rather than under this 19233 code

19267	Inter-Scapulo-Thoracic Socket – Socket Fee
19230	Shoulder Disarticulation Socket – Socket Fee
19229	Trans-Humeral Socket – Socket Fee
19228	Elbow Disarticulation Socket – Socket Fee
19227	Trans-Radial Socket – Socket Fee
19226	Wrist Disarticulation Socket – Socket Fee
19245	Partial Hand Procedure As this was not named in Socket fees, this is the code for partial hand procedure
19268	Early Post-Operative Procedure – Upper Extremity
19270	Diagnostic Socket – Upper Extremity Any test socket, whether dynamic or static
19273	Suction Procedure – Upper Extremity The extra knowledge required to prepare and cut out the cast and prepare for Suction Suspension. The valve and housing go under 19233 –Components .
19259	Lock Procedure – Upper Extremity The extra work involved in cast preparation, lamination, cut out, and installation of a lock for suspension of the prosthesis
19242	Socket Variations – Upper Extremity E.g. Wrist dis. door, Muenster, supra-epicondylar, flexible inner liner. Please specify socket variation under “Description.” <i>Note:</i> Suction Suspension procedure is separate under Item Code 19273 - Suction Procedure
19261	Electric Arm Technique Extra cost of double wall laminate necessary for wiring harness, etc. for electric prosthesis; that is, the amount over the appropriate socket fee for the electric socket procedure
19243	Suspensions and Additions – Upper Extremity Harnessing; cabling; straps, etc.

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19244	Socket Liners – Upper Extremity Any liner; e.g. Suction Seal, Alpha Lock, Cushion, and Custom (in house or Bock or other).
19286	Locking Devices – Upper Extremity
19249	Shoulder Joint
19248	Elbow and Hinges Elbow joints and all hinges; e.g. SP100. Includes elbow and forearm as provided by Hosmer and Bock.
19247	Wrist Units With inserts
19246	Terminal Devices, Body-Powered – Upper Extremity Hooks, hands, terminal adaptive devices (TAD), etc. <i>Note:</i> Sport terminal devices would be considered as Vocational Rehabilitation entitlement, not as a Health Care Benefit.
19272	Electric Elbow
19263	Electric Terminal Devices
19262	Electric Component All electric components other than those named individually under separate Item Codes, such as 19263 – Electric Terminal Devices and 19272 – Electric Elbow . Includes electrodes, batteries, charger cables, etc.
19260	Cosmetic Finishing – Upper Extremity
19255	Cosmetic Gloves Custom, Production, or any glove for covering the prosthetic terminal device
19288	Components – Upper Extremity

19251	Facial Ear(s), nose, Maxillo-Facial
19252	Ocular
General	
19250	Labour Includes repairs, adjustments, modifications, ocular polishing, as well as manufacturer's repairs, which are paid at actual cost. If materials are required also, they should be included separately under Item Code 19271 – Materials . Labour is included in all procedure costs. The only time Item Code 19250 – Labour would be added to a socket fee or procedure would be for an unusual procedure, which must be pre-approved with Form 83D19 (Request For Authorization For Prosthetic Services)
19253	Socks Any socks other than sheaths – 1 ply 5 ply specialty socks, etc.
19254	Sheath

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19258	Shrinkers and Tensors Includes pull socks and pull bags such as Eazy Proth
19271	Materials All repairs, adjustments, modifications, etc. require Labour 19250 ; some require materials. When both are needed, both codes must be used.
19257	Consumables Any powder, cleaner, cream or lotion that will be used up and need to be replaced
19289	Rental Charge For the provision of temporary foot or knee in limited circumstances while extended repairs are being undertaken
19279	Freight Charges For TP Repairs For shipping of TP (Third Party) Component Repairs
19280	Post Warranty Component Trials Pre-Approved Post-Warranty, Physiatry-Prescribed, component trial fee
